**DUBLIN POLICE SERVICES TO HOST A
“SPOOKTACULAR SAFETY FAIR” AND BLOOD DRIVE
SATURDAY, OCTOBER 3, 11:00 AM TO 3:00 PM**

DUBLIN, Calif., September 9, 2015 – Dublin Police Services will host a “Spooktacular Safety Fair” for residents of all ages on Saturday, October 3, from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., at the Dublin Civic Center (100 Civic Plaza). Kids can enjoy arts and crafts, bounce houses, a dunk tank, Bike Mobile, and Trick or Treat bags (for the first 300 attendees). The Alameda County Transportation Commission’s Bike Mobile will also provide no-cost bicycle repair and bike safety tips to encourage more kids to ride their bikes to school, while the Tri-Valley Animal Rescue will feature pet adoptions.

For the adults in the family, the California Highway Patrol will provide free car seat installations and inspections, and the American Red Cross will host a blood drive in Dublin’s City Hall from 11:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Residents wishing to donate blood can register for the blood drive at www.redcross.org, and search “DublinCommunity.” Drop-ins are also welcome.

Most of the activities and treats at the safety fair will be free of charge, but some will request a nominal cost. Proceeds will be donated to the City of Dublin’s Youth Fee Assistance program.

Other organizations participating in the Spooktacular Safety Fair include Alameda County Explorers, Alameda County Fire, Babies R Us, Bricks for Kidz, Dublin Library, Dublin San Ramon Services District, East County Animal Shelter and Field Services, Office of Emergency Services, PG&E, and Whole Foods Market.
