### **CITY OF DUBLIN TO HOST PUBLIC MEETINGS TO GATHER INPUT ON ARTS**

**DUBLIN, Calif., June 22, 2016** – The City of Dublin, as part of a Cultural Arts Needs Assessment, will host an open public meeting on Monday, June 27, 7:00-8:30 p.m., at Dublin City Hall (100 Civic Plaza) to encourage members of the public to comment on arts programming and facilities they would like to see implemented in Dublin.

Dublin is also hosting several focus group discussions geared to particular interests:

- Teens: Monday, June 27, 3:30 p.m., Dublin Senior Center
- Parents of children in grades K-5: Tuesday, June 28, 8:30 a.m., Dublin Heritage Park Picnic Tables (660 Donlon Way);
- Parents of preschoolers: Tuesday, June 28, 10:30 a.m., Dublin Heritage Park Picnic Tables

Those who can't attend the public meeting or a focus group can still participate in a survey about arts programs and facilities. The online survey is open through June 30 and can be accessed at: <http://tinyurl.com/DublinArtsSurvey>.

The survey asks about current arts participation and interest in cultural arts activities. The data gathered will be used to inform future decisions regarding arts programming in Dublin, including possible re-use of the Dublin Police wing at City Hall as a Cultural Arts Center after Police Services relocates to the Dublin Public Safety Complex. Survey results and recommendations will be presented to the Dublin City Council in October.

Those completing the survey have the option to provide their email address to be entered into a drawing to win a \$100 gift certificate from Whole Foods. An independent consultant is tallying surveys, so all responses remain anonymous.
