

Express Lanes Opening Soon in Dublin

In the next few weeks, Alameda County Transportation Commission (ACTC) will unveil new express lanes along the I-580 corridor. Using the [new FasTrak Flex toll tags](#), solo drivers will be able to access express lanes that are toll-free for carpools, vanpools, motorcycles, buses and eligible clean-air vehicles. The I-580 Express Lanes will operate from 5 am to 8pm, Mondays through Friday.



FasTrak Flex toll tags will replace the current standard FasTrak toll tags, allowing carpools (and other eligible users) to access the lanes at all times. To learn more about the new I-580 Express Lanes and FasTrak Flex toll tags, visit the [ACTC website](#).
