Welcome to the 2016 Bat Busters season. Opening Day is on Saturday, September 10. Player's t-shirts will be distributed at the first game. A brief parent's meeting will also be held during each team's first game.

**Games:** Players will always warm up first, do drills and receive instruction on the fundamentals of the game before playing a game against another team. No score is kept during the games. Staff focuses on helping players learn the game and have fun. Each team will get the same number of batting opportunities. Staff will act as the official team coaches, but parents are highly encouraged to participate on the field and in the dugouts.

**Fallon Sports Park:** Parents and spectators may sit in the bleachers or bring lawn chairs. Dogs must be on leash and cannot be in the dugouts or on the field. Please no sunflower seeds or gum for the players.

**Snacks:** Parents will be asked to volunteer by taking turns providing snacks for their team. A sign-up list will be circulated at the first game. Snacks consist of something very simple such as an individual juice box and a package of crackers or cookies for each player.

**What to Bring:** Players should bring a fielding glove, cap and a water bottle. Please do not bring bats and balls. Those are provided by the league and have been approved for their safety. Helmets are not used by the league. If you wish for your child to wear a helmet while running the bases, please provide one for them. Temperatures could be warm, so please remember to have your child use sunscreen.
