**ADULT SPORTS - 2019 SPRING SEASON
SOFTBALL LEAGUES**

The City of Dublin is offering Adult Slow-pitch Spring softball leagues. Resident teams may register in person at the Shannon Community Center at 11600 Shannon Avenue in Dublin on Mondays – Fridays from 8:00 am – 5:00 pm. Non-Resident teams may register in person at the Shannon Center or online at www.dublinrecguide.com

On www.dublinrecguide.com If creating an account for the first time, please create a “Team” not a “Family” account. Leagues are visible by selecting the tab “Search/Register” then “League Search”.

Teams will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Spring teams will be added less than two weeks before the start of the season only if space is available and then a **\$25 late registration fee will apply**.

REGISTRATION WILL REQUIRE:

- 1) A completed registration form. Also, all individual players will be asked to complete a **Player Waiver and Release Form** once during the calendar year. The Player Waiver and Release Form and House Rules are available on the City’s website (www.dublin.ca.gov) or emailed out by request to robert.beasley@dublin.ca.gov
- 2) Complete payment of the fees. No partial payments accepted. Checks made payable to "City of Dublin."

Players are requested to have uniform tops with numbers. This is to help the scorekeepers and umpires.

LEAGUE FORMAT: All games will be played at the **Fallon Sports Park**, 4605 Lockhart Street.

MEN’S - (Activity code #PE4020)	“Low C/High D”	Tuesdays	beginning April 9, 2019 (register by March 26 to avoid late fee)
COED - (Activity code #PE4010)	“D” League	Thursdays	beginning April 11, 2019 (register by March 28 to avoid late fee)

Please note: Each league consists of an eight-game regular season with the top teams advancing to single elimination playoffs. A minimum of 50% of the teams will qualify for the playoffs. However, the league format is subject to change depending on registration.

LEAGUE FEES: \$672 for Resident teams \$806 for Non-Resident teams

Resident/Non Resident Status:

To qualify as a resident team: 51% of the roster must be Dublin residents or must be sponsored by a Dublin based business with a current business license and pay by company check or credit card. Resident team registration must be done in person at the Dublin Senior Center, not online.
