The entry fee must be submitted along with the completed application. Please make all checks or money orders payable to ***Dublin Lions Club***.

Upon acceptance, you will receive parade instructions along with a map of the parade route.

After the parade, please plan to continue the celebration by visiting the Dublin Civic Center for the St. Patrick's Day Celebration where you can enjoy three stages of Celtic entertainment and dance, shop for authentic Irish wares and crafts, and partake of delicious Irish food and drink. The Festival takes place from 10:00am to 5:00pm on Saturday and Sunday, at 100 Civic Plaza, at the corner of Dublin Blvd. and Civic Plaza.

PARADE POLICIES, & REGULATIONS

ENTRY DEADLINE

Friday, February 12, 2016

All participants in the Annual Dublin Lions Club St. Patrick's Day Parade must agree to the following:

- 1) In consideration of inclusion as a participant in the St. Patrick's Day Parade, participant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Dublin Lions Club and Lions International and their members, agents, performers, and/or volunteers from any claims, demands, costs or judgments arising from participant's involvement in the 2016 St. Patrick's Day Parade.
- 2) The Parade Committee reserves the right to refuse or remove any entry, which, in their opinion, does not conform to the parade rules.
- 3) **ALL** entries and vehicles entered in the Parade must be distinctive and decorated.
- 4) **All participants MUST be in costume. All costumes must be appropriate for a family friendly audience.**
- 5) No single entry may exceed **25** participants unless pre-approved by the Parade Committee.
- 6) All parade vehicles must be in sound mechanical condition, be equipped with a tow bar or chain mounted in the front of the vehicle; must carry an emergency portable fire extinguisher; and must be in the assigned formation position and be ready for inspection by the Dublin Fire Department and Parade Committee by the appropriate time.
- 7) Entry must be covered by adequate insurance.
- 8) Commercial advertising is allowed by commercial entries **ONLY**.
- 9) All signs are to be approved in writing by the Parade Committee. No philosophical, political, or religious messages may be incorporated into the signs or used in any entry in the parade without permission of the Parade Committee.
- 10) **NO OBJECTS (i.e. CANDY etc)** of any kind are to be **THROWN** at the parade spectators.
- 11) All entries using sound equipment must specify type of equipment and use in the Parade Application.
- 12) Parade placement is at the sole discretion of the Parade Committee.
